I'M PACKING MY SUITCASE

Lay out all of the cards face-up in the middle of the table. The youngest player starts.

Getting started: Take any card and say out loud:

"I'm packing my suitcase and will take a(n) ... with me."

Complete this sentence with the item shown on your card. Then turn the card over and lay it aside, facedown. This is now the discard pile. Play then continues in a clockwise direction.

The next person takes a card and repeats the sentence "I'm packing my suitcase and will take a(n) ... with me". List the items already mentioned. Your fellow players must listen to see if you make any mistakes:

- Got it right? Did you repeat the list of items without forgetting anything? Then add your new item to the list. Place your card face-down on the discard pile. Now it's your left neighbor's turn.
- Got it wrong? Did someone notice a mistake in your list of items? Have you forgotten an item or mixed up the order? Oh dear—then you're out unfortunately! Put your card back in the middle of the table. Now it's your left neighbor's turn.

Check how your fellow players get on:

Are you unsure whether a fellow player has listed everything correctly? The discard pile can help here.

The player's right neighbor takes the discard pile and reveals it card by card. So you can check if everything was correct. Then put the pile back at the side in the same order.

End of the game:

The last player to list all items in the correct order wins. Have all of the cards been added to the pile and several players are still in the game? Then there are multiple winners!
